With the end of one year we look forward to the next year with anticipation and excitement for what is to come. We do have one major change that we had been telling you about toward the end of this previous season. It looks like Roberson Museum has given us the green light to change our meeting days from the first and third Fridays to the **SECOND & FOURTH FRIDAYS** so that more of our members and guests don't have to debate over getting to join us or visiting and showing for First Friday. Now we can do both and hopefully this will help everyone out in the long run. This may take a little while for everyone to adjust to but, this way you now have one more week to get your submissions ready and that is never a bad thing.

We have also made a small change to our submission size guidelines. Before, we were allowing 5x7 size images (outer dimension) but we have run into an issue with images that small getting caught in some of the larger mats from other pictures. This isn't too much of an issue if the only thing that happens is that we get our line-up out of order but there could be an occasion where the smaller print could cause damage to the larger one and that is what we are trying to prevent by doing this. So starting in the fall the smallest outer dimension that we can have in competition is 8X10". This still means you can submit 5X7 pictures but they just have to be matted or mounted to something no smaller than 8X10. Hopefully everyone understands why we have done this and isn't inconvenienced by it.

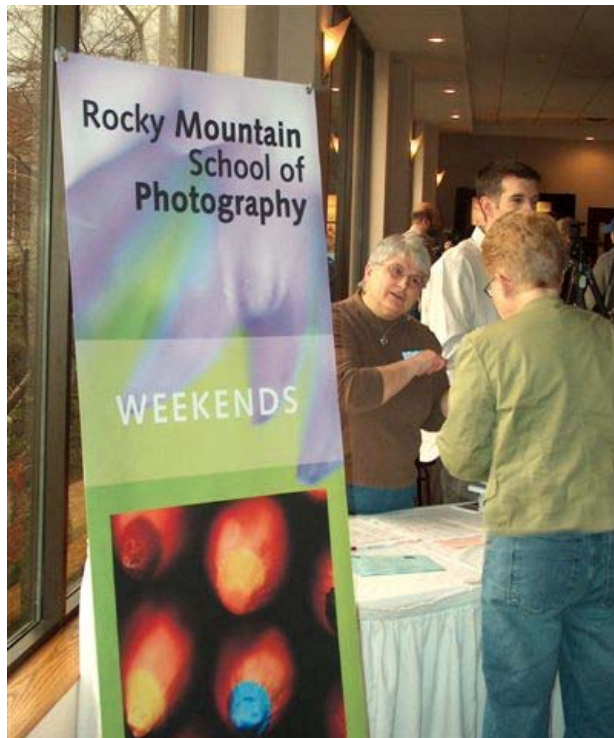

Here are the guidelines:

Images are to be no larger than 8x12 and matted no larger than 12x16 unframed. Color, B/W, film or digital will be accepted although there will be no separate divisions for different media. Submissions will be separated into classes 'B', 'A', and Salon and the members attending the

meeting can vote on all three classes of images. A people's choice method of selecting the winners will be used.

Please have your submissions ready for the 1<sup>st</sup> club meeting on September 28, 2007. Prints will be displayed and voted on at this meeting.
